Choosing the Right Color Based on Lighting

Selecting the ideal color involves considering the lighting in your space. Natural light can enhance bold colors like reds and yellows, while artificial lighting may mute these tones. Test samples under various conditions to ensure the best result.

Type of Paint (Matte, Semi-Gloss, Gloss)

Matte finishes hide wall imperfections but are harder to clean. Semi-gloss provides durability with a slight sheen, suitable for busy areas. Gloss finishes offer high durability and a reflective surface, ideal for trim or furniture.

Preparation and Wall Repair

Start with a clean surface by washing walls and filling cracks. Sanding rough areas and repairing drywall ensure a smooth base, preventing future paint issues.

Ventilation and Drying Time

Ensure good airflow with open windows and fans to reduce fumes and speed drying. Matte paints may dry in 4-6 hours, while gloss can take up to 24 hours before recoating, depending on humidity.

Protecting Furniture and Flooring

Cover furniture with drop cloths and tape off floors. Use plastic sheeting for larger areas to avoid paint splatter, keeping your space clean during the process.
